



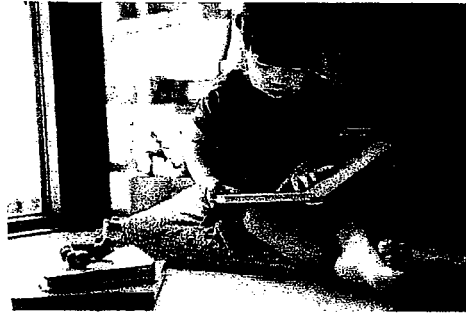
## 2024-2025 Kindergarten Supply List

# Summer Reading for Future Kindergartener

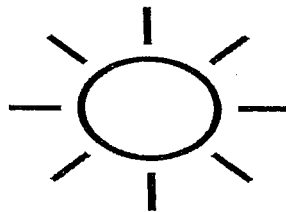


Be sure to read throughout the summer.
